

It was not till recently that I realized my jaw bone was gradually melting away from the pressure of dentures on my gums. I tried using denture glues, but they didn't work well, and I was spending a lot of money. The denture is so loose now that I cannot keep it in place, even during normal talking. It's really embarrassing. I like to go out a lot and spend time with family and friends. And I also like to eat. But just can't. It's just horrible.”

That all changed when Mary decided to look into dental implants. Although she had suffered bone loss from years of denture use, through careful digital diagnostics and planning, we were able to provide her with five dental implants which ultimately supported a new fixed set of teeth for her. 
## Problems with dentures

# Destructive Effects of Full Dentures



Dentures place a tremendous amount of load on the supporting bone and gum tissue leading to gradual shrinkage. As the bone recedes, the denture loses its fit and becomes increasingly loose. A new denture relines and addition of new denture material may improve the fit however creates thicker and heavier teeth that become more difficult to keep in. The bone and gum tissue shrink again repeating the same cycle.



This high performance option provides you with fixed implant-supported teeth that you can wear all the time- 24 hours a day offering most comfort and stability.

Easy to clean, strong, and aesthetically superior.

## All-On-4



- Smaller jaw size
- Lower bite loads
- Bone loss in back when grafting is not possible

## All-On-5



- Medium jaw size
- Moderate bite loads
- Bone loss in back

## All-On-6



- Larger jaw size
- Higher bite loads
- Available bone in back or when it can be grafted

# Removable Overdenture



- Supported by 2, 3, or 4 implants
- Great stability and aesthetics
- Overdenture is easily removable for cleaning
- Preserves jaw bone from traumatic effect of regular dentures

# Implant Placement Scenarios


Dental implants may be placed either immediately at the time of teeth extractions or later after the sites have healed (delayed). The ideal treatment scenario will be determined by your team dentists consisting of a surgeon and restorative dentist.

## Immediate

The implants are placed at the time of teeth extractions

*done when...*

- Non-periodontally involved teeth
- Adequate bone is present
- Primary stability can be achieved



## Delayed

The implants are placed in 2-6 months after extractions

*done when...*

- Periodontally involved teeth
- Inadequate bone (need grafting)
- Primary stability cannot be achieved

# Implant Restoration Options


Once the implants have been placed, it may be possible to deliver a set of temporary teeth supported on the implants on the same day (immediate load) or later once the implants have healed in staged fashion. The ideal treatment scenario will be determined by your team dentists consisting of a surgeon and restorative dentist.

## Immediate

The restorations are placed on the same day as the implants

*done when...*

- Excellent implant primary stability
- Compliant patient
- Load can be controlled




## Delayed

The restorations are placed later once the implants have healed

*done when...*

- Poor implant stability
- Non-compliant patient
- Excessive load cannot be controlled

# Simple ,Transparent & Global Fees

Our dental implant fee structure is **simple, transparent, and inclusive**. One payment for all of your surgical and restorative needs. Our **global implant fees include all of the following**:

- Consultations
- Planning

- All follow-up appointments and X-rays

We use only the most well known and researched implant companies in our office, including Straumann, Zimmer, Astra, and Nobel. We do not use the lower quality and cheap clone dental implants which lack research and quality assurance and are associated with increased risk of failure, infection, fractures, and poor healing.

Dental implants and related bone grafting procedures are typically not covered by any insurance plans as they are considered elective and not medically necessary. Dental implants may be covered by medical insurance if teeth loss is related to a traumatic injury or pathology such as bony cysts. Contact your insurance company or call us for assistance.

We offer bone grafting procedures when there is inadequate bone for support of the implants. We also offer various anesthesia options including local anesthesia, nitrous oxide, or IV sedation.



Our remarkable 3-D cone beam imaging system allows us to capture detailed images of your entire jaw, which helps us diagnose any underlying condition that could affect the outcome of your implant procedure. If we identify bone loss, gum disease or tooth decay anywhere in your mouth, we will perform necessary interventions—building new bone, filling cavities or treating gums—before securing your dental implant. We also use our 3-D imaging system to position your implants at the precise location and angle for ideal functionality and appearance.

When appropriate, we use a 3-D digital impression scanner to create an impression of your mouth, eliminating the need for plastic trays and putty. We then use specialized computer technology to design and fabricate replacement teeth that are exactly the right size, shape and color.


